For the past two years, due to costs, attempts to maintain a permanently staffed National office have been unsuccessful and the following decisions have been made to maintain SAALED, but in a different manner -

- SAALED Gauteng will be taking over the functions of the national committee on a much smaller scale.
- Paid-up membership is no longer viable,
- People attending any SAALED function will automatically be added to the membership database.
- The functioning branches will continue to organise regular meetings, mini conferences and workshops in their areas.
- Communication between the branches will remain.
- Annual audits will be conducted by the appointed auditors.
- The newsletter and sponsorships will be discontinued.
